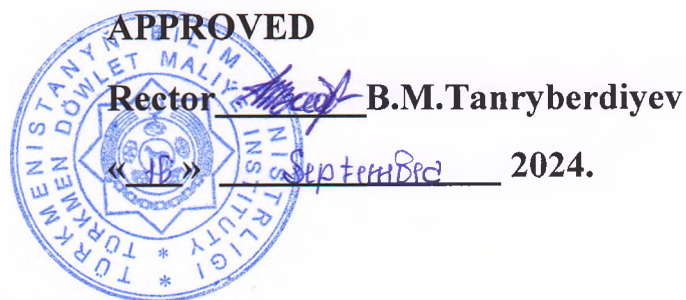

REGULATION

**on the organization and holding of the open international Internet Olympiad
among students on the subject of "International Financial Reporting
Standards"**

These regulations were prepared for the organization and holding of the open international Internet Olympiad among students on the subject of **"International Financial Reporting Standards"** in order to fulfill the instructions of the **President of Turkmenistan** to establish and develop international cooperation in the field of higher professional education, deepen the theoretical knowledge of students in various areas of the economy and improve practical skills.

I. General regulations

1. These Regulations determine the procedure for organizing and holding the open international Internet Olympiad on the subject of "International Financial Reporting Standards" among students of higher educational institutions.
2. The open international Internet Olympiad will help identify talented students who are able to independently solve problems on the subject of "International Financial Reporting Standards".
3. The purpose of the Open International Internet Olympiad is:
 - a) Deepening theoretical knowledge and improving practical skills of students of higher education institutions in the subject of "International Financial Reporting Standards";
 - b) Developing students' thinking and worldview in the subject of "International Financial Reporting Standards";
 - c) organizing an exchange of opinions between the teaching staff and students of higher education institutions;
 - d) training young specialists capable of making appropriate management decisions.

4. The function of the Open International Internet Olympiad is:
 - a) generating interest in solving problems in the subject of "International Financial Reporting Standards" using digital technologies;
 - b) identifying talented and capable young people, creating positive conditions for their intellectual development;
 - c) implementing interaction between higher education institutions through digital information and communication technologies.

II. Organizational and methodological support for the Olympiad

5. An organizing group is created to provide general guidance on organizing and holding the open international Internet Olympiad among students of higher education institutions on the subject of "International Financial Reporting Standards". The composition of the organizing group is approved by the order of the rector of the Turkmen State Institute of Finance.
6. The organizing group:
 - a) determines the basic principles for holding the open international Internet Olympiad on the subject of "International Financial Reporting Standards" among students of higher education institutions, and also performs organizational tasks for organizing and holding the Olympiad;
 - b) prepares recommendations, instructions and methodological manuals for determining the procedure and timing of the Olympiad;
 - c) carries out the necessary work to study the Olympiad issues with representatives of higher education institutions of Turkmenistan and foreign countries.

III. Procedure for organizing and holding the Olympiad

7. Students studying in the curriculum of the specialty/field of study of higher educational institutions of Turkmenistan and foreign countries can participate in the Olympiad.
8. No more than 4 (four) students from each higher educational institution can participate in the Olympiad.
9. Official working languages - **Turkmen, English and Russian.**
10. Information about the Olympiad participants must be sent to the e-mail address of the Turkmen State Institute of Finance at info@tdmai.edu.tm before **October 15, 2024.**
11. The Olympiad will be held on **November 1, 2024** on the official website of the Turkmen State Institute of Finance via the Moodle platform. Start time - **12:00** (Ashgabat time).

12. The Olympiad on the subject of "International Financial Reporting Standards" will offer 10 (ten) problems, for the solution of which **120 (one hundred twenty)** minutes will be allocated.
13. Each participant in the Olympiad must independently complete the tasks. During the Olympiad, students are not allowed to talk to each other and use various publications. Students who do not comply with these rules will be excluded from the Olympiad.
14. The jury of the Olympiad will include representatives of higher educational institutions and scientific and educational institutions of Turkmenistan and foreign countries. The composition and chairman of the jury are approved by the order of the rector of the Turkmen State Institute of Finance.
15. The jury evaluates the work of the students participating in the Olympiad and summarizes the results.
16. Complaints are considered by the jury members, and the final decision is made by the chairman of the jury. The results presented following the appeal are final and cannot be appealed.

V. Procedure for determining and awarding the winners of the Olympiad

17. The result of the Olympiad is determined by the total number of points scored in the individual competition.
18. The results of the Olympiad are recorded in protocols, and the list of winners based on the jury's results is approved by the order of the rector of the Turkmen State Institute of Finance.
19. The total number of winners should not exceed 50% of the participants. Diplomas are issued in the ratio 1:2:3.
20. The winners of the Olympiad are awarded Diplomas of the 1st, 2nd and 3rd degree.
21. Students who have fully solved 6 (six) problems at the Olympiad, but failed to take a prize place, are awarded a motivational certificate of honor.

Rules of conduct during the open Internet Olympiad

A student participating in the open Internet Olympiad must comply with the following rules of conduct:

1. A student may have writing utensils (pen, pencil) with him/her. Other items, including mobile phones (switched off), must be left in the designated place;
 2. Participants in the Internet Olympiad have the right to use calculators;
 3. A student works only with tasks intended to solve problems within the framework of the Internet Olympiad;
 4. Computers and webcams must be constantly connected to the Internet;
 5. During the Internet Olympiad, students are not allowed to talk, pass things to each other, use mobile or other means of communication;
- The duration of the Internet Olympiad is 120 minutes.
